POLICY LETTER 9-14

From: Commanding Officer, 2d Low Altitude Air Defense Battalion
To: All Hands

Subj: COMMANDER'S POLICY ON HAZING

1. Do not engage in hazing. You cannot consent to being the subject of hazing. Hazing is unlawful, prohibited by Marine Corps Order, and will not be tolerated in this Battalion.
2. Most importantly, set the conditions in your small units so that hazing does not occur. Sound, small unit leadership is the key to success.
3. Do not allow the weak act of hazing to destroy trust, erode unit cohesion, lower morale, and tarnish the outstanding reputation of this Battalion. We are better and more combat ready when every Marine is treated with dignity and respect.
4. If you become aware of an incident of hazing, report it immediately. This Battalion will fully investigate every allegation of hazing, and anyone who practices or tolerates hazing will be subject to appropriate disciplinary and administrative action.
